VUOM Founder’s Scholarship Application

Virginia University of Oriental Medicine offers supplemental institutionally funded scholarship programs throughout the year to eligible students who demonstrate excellent academic achievement.

Founder’s Scholarship Guidelines

- This Scholarship is limited to new students starting Master of Science in Oriental Medicine program for the following Quarters: Spring 2017 Quarter, Summer 2017 Quarter, Fall 2017 Quarter.
 - This scholarship is limited to 2 students per Quarter.
 - This Scholarship fund is applied to tuition expenses only and covers 50% of the student’s didactic courses. Clinical Internships and other administration fees are not included.
 - The awardee must be enrolled as a full time student of VUOM and maintain a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.7 or above every quarter.
 - The awardee must participate in a school sponsored community outreach event at least two times per year.
 - The award decisions are determined and granted by the VUOM Scholarship Committee.
 - The application due date is 2 weeks before the new Quarter begins.
